The convertible beanie

YOU NEED:

Set of five 4,5 mm DPN:s

Set of five 5,0 mm DPN:s

2 balls of OnLine Linie 157 Tessa, 100% wool, 50 g / 85 m, colour #73. Alternatives: for example Rowan Pure Wool Aran, Rowan Scottish Tweed DK, Rowan Felted Tweed, Malabrigo Worsted... basically any worsted/aran weight wool/wool mix yarn would be fine!

GAUGE:

22 sts of k2 - p2 rib (not stretched) = 10 cm (3,9 in) on 4,5 needles

Size:

56 cm +2 cm. Adjust the edge band just picking smaller or larger needles for small adjustments. For larger changes the pattern is easy to adjust in 4 sts increments when casting on.

INSTRUCTIONS:

With the smaller needles cast on 116 sts. Distribute the stitches to the needles: 28 sts for the first three, 32 to the fourth. Place marker, join sts to round, careful not to twist them. Start k2-p2 ribbing, knit 7 rounds total.

Change to larger needles. *K2, p1, M1 (pick yarn between sts by left side front of the needle) purling the new stitch, p1*, repeat ** to the end of round (marker).

Knit k2 - p3 rib until the piece measures 17,5 cm (6,7 in).

K2, p2tog, p1, repeat ** to the end of round (marker). Knit 2 additional rounds of k2 - p2 ribbing.

K2tog, p2tog, repeat to the end of round (marker). Knit five rounds of k1 - p1 ribbing.

Ssk, repeat to the end of round (marker). Knit one round.

Cut yarn leaving 10 cm (4 in) tail. Pull the tail through remaining 29 stitches and pull the yarn to the wrong side. Weave in ends.

Wet block and stretch, especially if you want to emphasize the beret look.

Wear and enjoy!
